

WOW, WE DID IT AGAIN! I know everyone is as excited as the Pumpkin Patch Committee that the 2019 Pumpkin Patch is over and was such a great success.

Thanks to the Youth Challenge Program, CADA, Oakwood Home, BPPC Nursing Students and all the other volunteers who helped set up the patch and unload the truck. We could not have done this all by ourselves. Our total sales were \$28,503.50 and with a little help from our Face Book Thanksgiving Decoration Advertisement, our Pastor and donations from our wonderful church family, we earned a 40% profit. That means we will have \$10,500 plus to give away to local much peopled Missions.

Story Time was another huge success. We entertained 1,092 kids in nine days. Eight units of blood were selflessly given in the Blood drive. Our Cookies sales were enjoyed to the tune of \$627, and the Boutique Craft Shop yielded \$1,034. As you know the Pumpkin Patch Committee is always up to trying new things every year. This year we had a Crafter Market which brought in \$300 and Crafters 4 Missions that also brought in \$300. Painting Gourds was another fun thing for the kiddos to do; Thanks to Bobby for supplying all the small gourds which we sold and then provided paint and instructions to decorate. The Family Pumpkin Carving was another fun event and with a little tweaking has the potential to turn into a profitable event.

In a few weeks we will announce the time and date of our Annual Appreciation Dinner for all our volunteers. We definitely want to show our church congregation how much we appreciate you and let you hear some wonderful stories from the local Missions to which we will be awarding the money.

Thanks to all you talented folks who brought cookies and made things for us to sell in the Boutique. To all of you who worked endless hours in the patch, I cannot thank you enough! We are "St. Luke's Strong!"
